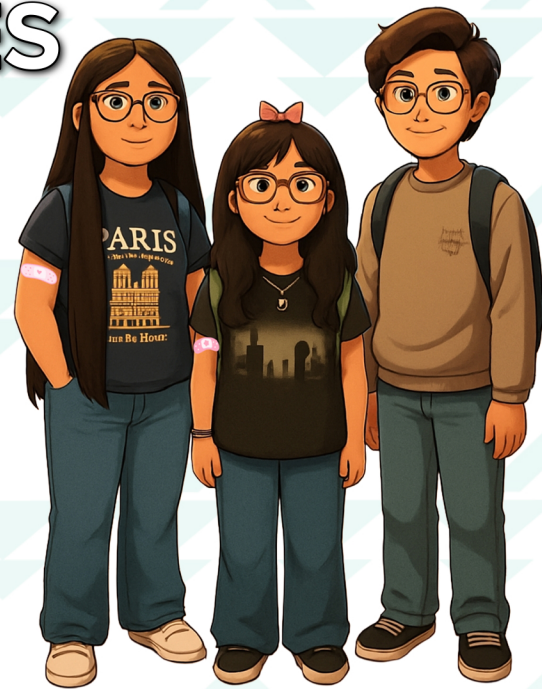
CHILDHOOD VACCINES

On January 5, 2026, the CDC changed some national vaccine recommendations for children. Some vaccines are now recommended only for certain high-risk children.

In New Mexico, vaccines are still recommended for all age-eligible children by the NM Department of Health and pediatric experts. These vaccines are safe, effective, and still covered by insurance.

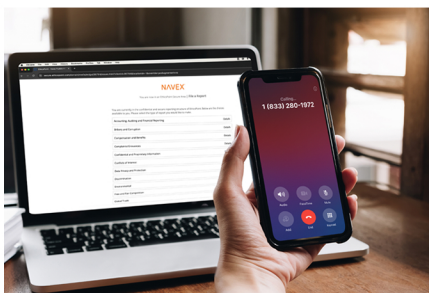
